- Effective April 1, 2024, BCBS-NC is removing their Healthline Blue phone number, which is currently located on the back of the medical ID card. With this change, BCBS-NC will be reissuing new medical ID cards to your worksite employees, even if they do not change their plan during open enrollment. It is important to note, that the only change to the ID card is the removal of the Healthline Blue phone number.
- The BCBSNC HDHP 3000 plan will no longer be offered for the new plan year. Worksite
 employees who do not actively make an election during open enrollment will be
 automatically enrolled in the BCBSNC HDHP 3500 plan. Please reference the client
